### RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION

A Sign of our Communion with God and Union with Others

It is always good for those of us who come to the table each week to pause and recall the proper way to share in Holy Communion.

At the time of the Communion procession when the person in front of you has received Holy Communion and you are in the front of the procession you will bow your head, the Minister of the Body of Christ will say, "The Body of Christ", you will reply, "Amen". It is important to note that the only appropriate response is Amen. The Church expects that Amen is said in a voice that can be heard by the Minister of Holy Communion. After saying Amen you will receive the Body of Christ, step to the side and consume the host immediately. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal indicates that when standing before the Minister of Communion the faithful should make a simple bow of the head. (par. 160) This common sign of reverence is made once, before receiving the Body of Christ. The Blessed Sacrament is being reverenced. When the priest sits down after Communion we sit or kneel for silent prayer.
