

# THE SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD



In September 2019
Pope Francis
instituted *Sunday of the Word of God*, to
be held each year
on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in
Ordinary Time.
In establishing a *Sunday of the Word of God* Pope Francis
is inviting us to have

a deeper appreciation for the place and importance of Sacred Scripture in our lives.

In the General Instruction to the Roman Missal (GIRM) we read: "The Church invites us to listen reverently to the Word of God as it is proclaimed. (par. 29) In the readings the table of God's Word is spread before the faithful, and the treasures of the bible are opened to them." (par.57)

Before coming to Mass (Sunday and weekday) we are encouraged to read the Scriptures at home so we are ready to listen as the Word of God is proclaimed.

The celebration of the Sunday of the Word of God has ecumenical value, since the Scriptures point out, for those who listen, the path to authentic and firm unity." (Apostolic Letter, Instituting Sunday of the Word of God, par.3).
