THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 2, 2022



There are two feasts that we celebrate outside the Christmas cycle that are closely connected to Christmas, the Presentation of the Lord

on February 2nd is one and the Annunciation of the Lord on March 25th is the other.

The Presentation of the Lord is celebrated 40 days after Christmas, an old English title for this feast is Candlemas. In the gospel we hear the prayer of an old man Simeon who was promised by the Holy Spirit that he would not die until he had seen Christ the Lord. As Simeon held the infant Jesus in his arms he recognized Christ as the light for the world. The words that Simeon says are part of our Gospel Canticle for Night Prayer. Candles may be lit on this feast day as a sign that we are to follow the light of Christ.

This feast dates back to the middle of the 4th century. There is a report that a candlelight procession was connected with this 40th day after Christmas. Interestingly there was an ancient pagan procession that took place around the beginning of February, so like other celebrations the Christians brought new meaning to a known practice.

The candles that were carried in the Christian procession are a reminder that on this day Simeon called Jesus "a light for revelation to the gentiles". On the day of our baptism we receive a lit candle and are directed to keep the flame of faith burning brightly.

You are invited to bring your own candles to Mass today, they will be blessed and you may take them home. We will have extra candles available.

The fourth Joyful Mystery of the Rosary is the Presentation in the Temple. As you mark this feast you are invited to light a candle and pray the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary.
