SHARING IN HOLY COMMUNION: A SIGN OF OUR COMMUNION WITH GOD AND UNION WITH OTHERS

Our sharing in Holy Communion is both a profoundly public, and deeply personal act; yet there is nothing private about the Communion procession. It is most definitely a holy union with our Lord, Jesus Christ and with our brothers and sisters in Christ.

In 2011, the Canadian Bishops instructed that our common sign of reverence before sharing in Holy Communion be a bow of the head. The Church's ritual does not expect anyone to genuflect, kneel or make the sign of the cross before or after receiving Holy Communion. The normative way to receive communion is standing. To receive on our knees disrupts the procession, and draws attention to oneself, and is a misplaced sense of piety.

The Communion procession is a time of communal prayer. We sing the Communion hymn as an outward sign of our unity. We sit or kneel for silent prayer when the priest sits down after Communion
