

A Sign of our Communion with God and Union with Others

Beginning this weekend, April 27 /28, a number of our young people will begin to share in Holy Communion. They and their parents have been preparing for months. This is an ideal time to review the process for sharing in Holy Communion.

Our sharing in Holy Communion is a profoundly public personal act. We process forward to share in Holy Communion. It is most definitely a holy union with Jesus and with our brothers and sisters in Christ. There is nothing private about the Communion procession. In 2011, the Canadian Bishops instructed that our common sign of reverence before sharing in Holy Communion be a bow of the head. The Church's ritual does not expect anyone to genuflect, kneel or make the sign of the cross before or after receiving Holy Communion.

At the time of Holy Communion when the person in front of you has received Holy Communion and you are in the front of the procession, you **bow your head**, the Minister of the Body of Christ will say, "The Body of Christ", you reply, "Amen".

It is important to note that the only appropriate response is *Amen*. The Church expects that *Amen* is said in a voice that can be heard by the Minister of Holy Communion.

After saying *Amen* the Minister of Communion places the host in your hand. You put the host in your mouth. If you are going to share in the Blood of Christ you move to the Minister and he / she says, "*The Blood of Christ*", you answer "*Amen*" and take the chalice and take a sip. Then you return to your place.

The Communion procession is a time of communal prayer. We sing the Communion hymn as an outward sign of our unity. We sit or kneel for silent prayer when the priest sits down after Communion.
