On the second Sunday of February each year, the Archdiocese of Toronto celebrates Marriage Sunday. In 2025, it will be celebrated on the weekend of February 8/9. This occasion highlights the importance of the

institution of marriage rooted in faith, affirms couples who strengthen our faith community through their witness, and complements World Marriage Sunday celebrations that take place across North America. Bishop Ivan Camilleri will preside at a special Mass on Sunday, February 9, 2025 at 2:30 p.m. at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica (65 Bond Street, Toronto).

All married couples will have an opportunity to renew their marriage commitment. All are welcome to attend. Couples celebrating a 25th, 40th, 50th, 60th or 60+ anniversary in 2025 may register for reserved seating. All other seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. Those who are unable to attend at the Cathedral are invited to join the celebration via livestream Mass. The broadcast will begin at 2:15 p.m.

Please note, for those interested in obtaining a Jubilee indulgence, requirements include receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation, attending Mass and offering prayers for the intention of the Holy Father. Confessions will be offered at least one hour prior to all celebrations noted below - all Masses will begin at 7:00 p.m. In the Northern Region St. Mary's, Barrie and Padre Pio Parish, Kleinburg are official Jubilee Pilgrimage Churches.

The Sunday of the Word of God - January 25, 2025



In September 2019, Pope Francis issued an Apostolic Letter instituting the Sunday of the Word of God. "The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the word of God. In the General Instruction to the Roman Missal (GIRM) we read: "The

Church invites us to listen reverently to the Word of God as it is proclaimed. (par. 29) and "In the readings the table of God's Word is spread before the faithful, and the treasures of the bible are opened to them." (par.57) The celebration of the Sunday of the Word of God has ecumenical value, since the Scriptures point out, for those who listen, the path to authentic and firm unity." (Apostolic Letter, Instituting Sunday of the Word of God, par.3). Before coming to Mass (Sunday and weekday) we are encouraged to read the Scripture at home so we are ready to listen as the Word of God is proclaimed.
