Lent Begins on Wednesday, March 5th, 2025



Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and Fridays in Lent - Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are universal days of fast and abstinence. The Church asks all Catholics to abstain from eating meat on Ash

Wednesday, Good Friday and the Fridays during Lent. IF meat is not a staple in your diet, you may choose to abstain from a different food or drink (i.e. alcohol, coffee). You may also choose to do an act of charity in place of abstaining from meat.

The church asks those between the ages of 14 and 59 to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. To fast is to eat one main meal and not to eat between meals. Those with medical conditions are exempt from the call to fast. Here in the parish on Ash Wednesday there will be a 12:10 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Throughout the season, there will an additional Mass each Wednesday at 12:10 p.m.
