The gospel today tells the story of Jesus' encounter at Jacob's well with the Samaritan woman.

The Church proclaims this passage from St. John's gospel as part of our preparation for Easter when we will renew

During this week of Lent, you are invited to focus on water. Fresh clean water is

not readily available to all people. You are invited to use a reusable water bottle, to include a prayer of gratitude for the gift of water, find the date of your baptism and record it on your family / personal calendar and to pray for those who are preparing for baptism. We are encouraged to continue the practice of fasting. As we continue to journey to the living waters of Easter you are asked to pray for our Elect who are preparing for Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

Celebrating a Scrutiny and the Word of God on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays in Lent

On March 23rd, March 30rd and April 6rd at all Sunday (Saturday evening) Masses the readings for the Liturgy of the Word will be from Year A.



We proclaim Year A readings because we will be celebrating a scrutiny with the elect. The Baptismal images in these readings are strong and offer reflection for us and the elect as we prepare to renew our baptismal promises at Easter.

The Church tells us that "The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out then strengthen all that is upright strong and good." As we journey through Lent, we are in solidarity with the Elect and reflect on how the interior of our hearts and lives need to be healed so all that is good and upright may be strengthened.

For those who prepare for Sunday Mass by reading the Scripture before Mass the *Living with Christ* missal includes the readings from Year A.

The cost is \$75.00 per youth.




