Trinity Sunday

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This is one of the few days in the liturgical year that we celebrate a doctrine and belief rather than an event (*i.e. Easter Sunday or Christmas*) or a person (*i.e. St. Joseph or Mary the Mother of God*) Today we celebrate our eternal God: the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Two prayers that embody our belief in the Trinity are: the Sign of the Cross and the Glory Be. Trinity Sunday is celebrated on the first Sunday after Pentecost.
