Parish Prayer Companions are men and women in our parish community who are not able to be engaged in active ministry yet who continue to have the desire to be of service within the parish.

They are commissioned by the pastor to pray for the ministries of the parish; both those who minister and those who are recipients of the ministry. They make a commitment to pray each day for a specific group within the parish community. This commitment is for one year, renewable if appropriate.

- The Pastor commissions each person to the Ministry of Parish Prayer Companion.
- The public commissioning takes place on or close to May 31st, the Feast of the Visitation.
